



PARASITE MANAGEMENT

Parasitism is one of the most common problems we see in large animals in this area. It can cause signs of weight loss, unthrifty coat, lethargy, diarrhea, anemia and can even lead to death. It is important to have all your animals checked on a regular basis to determine if there is a parasite problem and how it should be managed. We can easily check a fecal on one or several of your animals if you have a herd to determine the parasite load. The veterinarian will set up a deworming protocol curtailed to your individual needs. Parasite resistance is a huge problem and is caused by deworming that is not done appropriately. Overuse or incorrect use of dewormers allows the parasites to become resistant to these dewormers and then they are no longer as effective. This is why we strongly recommend having regular fecals done to determine the need for deworming and that way we can make sure you are using the appropriate dewormers.
